





# **Industrial zones**

- 670 ha industrial zone Anticipated by General Town Plan
- Zone A 4 blocks, planned for building of small business objects (non-production activities – trade, warehouses, services, garages, etc.)
- Zone B 19 lots (locations) for objects of production craft shops in majority
- Zone C 2,5ha,11 lots for small business with full utilities, all to be rented for 99 years through auction
- Zone D locations in this zone are planned for nonproduction (trade, warehouses, services, garages etc.) and production objects.
- **Zone E -** 14,5 ha, location is planned for industry.



## **Business Incubator Centre**



- First greenfield investment of a kind in Serbia
- Partners on project:
  - City of Krusevac
  - National Investment Plan
  - USAID MEGA programme
- Location industrial zone C
- Overall surface 1400m2
- Tenants 20 starting businesses, approximately 100 employees
- Project value approximately 1 000 000 €


